Creation Steps

Step 1: Navigate to Microsoft Intune Admin Center

1. Sign in to [Microsoft Intune Admin Center](#)

2. Authenticate with appropriate credentials for **veridocsdevlab.onmicrosoft.com** environment

Step 2: Navigate to Configuration Section

1. Select **Apps > App configuration policies**

Step 3: Create New Configuration

1. Click **+ Create** or **+ Create Policy**
2. Select appropriate platform and profile type

Step 4: Configure Basic Information

Step 5: Configure Settings

Step 7: Configure Assignments

Verification

Confirm Deployment

1. Return to configuration list
2. Verify **Veri-Tune App Config - Outlook Block External Images** appears in the list
3. Check assignment status shows expected targets
4. Monitor deployment status for any errors

Test Configuration

1. Identify a test device in assigned group
2. Wait for device check-in (or force sync)
3. Verify configuration applies successfully
4. Review any error logs or compliance status

Rollback Procedure

If issues occur with this configuration:

1. Navigate to the configuration in Intune
2. Option A: **Disable assignments** - Remove all group assignments
3. Option B: **Delete configuration** - Delete the entire policy
4. Monitor affected devices for configuration removal
5. Review issue and recreate with corrections
